  - Log Book (if issued)

<b>The Event</b>	The Event will be a Regularity conducted on a modified Rob Roy Hillclimb course utilising the Chicane and a shortened by moving the Finish Line to increase the breaking area at the top of the hill. The program will consist of a Familiarisation Run behind the Course Car, an untimed sighting run, and three (3) timed runs. There will be a Come & Try Class for those competitors new to Hillclimbing.
<b>The manner in which the results will be determined, and prizes awarded</b>	Timing will be electronic and be accurate to 1/100 <sup>th</sup> of a second. Class winners will be those competitors with the least variance across the 3 competition runs. The variance will be the aggregate of variances of the times for runs 2 and 3 against the base time of run 1. Trophies will be awarded for first, second and third placings in each class. In addition, a trophy will be awarded for Least Time Variance of the Day. Trophies will be presented at the conclusion of the competition. These results will be available on the MG Car Club's website - <a href="http://www.robroyhillclimb.com.au">www.robroyhillclimb.com.au</a> in the week following the Event.

**ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRIES**

Entries will be by invitation only. With the high-powered nature of these vehicles an invitation will be given only to entrants with suitable prior motorsport experience. Less experienced entrants will be offered an entry to the Come & Try Class and be assigned a mentor. The Event Secretary will complete the entries in the Motorsport Australia Event Entry System on behalf of the entrant.

Notification of acceptance of entry will be forwarded by email to all Competitors in the week prior to the Event. This advice will also include Further Regulations and other additional specific information on the running of Hillclimb events at Rob Roy.

- Protests must be lodged in accordance with the NCR.
- The Organiser reserves the right to abandon, postpone or stop the Event in accordance with the NCR.
