EVENT DESCRIPTION

- The Event will be a Club Hillclimb, to be conducted at ROB ROY HILLCLIMB, 375 Clintons Road Smiths Gully VIC 3760 (Melway Map Ref 265 A9) on Sunday 5th May 2024. over a distance of 670 metres in a single direction. (note the Event will be run utilising the original track layout).
- The Event will also include a Come & Try Class for a limited number of entrants.

ENTRIES

Entries are open with the Publication of these Regulations, and close on the Wednesday 1st May 2024. The Entry Fee is \$120, Juniors are free. Second Driver and or Car is \$80. Entry is via the Motorsport Australia Event Entry system which is available at: - www.motorsport.org.au.

- Entries will be accepted in order of receipt unless otherwise specified.
- The Organisers may refuse any entry in accordance with NCR.
- Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed/consented to by a parent/guardian.
- The Organiser reserves the right to abandon, postpone or stop the Event in accordance with the NCR.
- Protests must be lodged in accordance with the NCR.

AWARDS

Trophies will be awarded for first place only in each class and a trophy will be awarded for the Fastest Time of the Day Historic Car and the Fastest Female Competitor. Trophies will be presented at conclusion of the competition.

TIMING

Timing will be electronic and be accurate to 1/100th of a second. Class winners will be those competitors with the Fastest time for a single run in each class. In the event of a tie, the next fastest official time of each competitor will determine the class winner. Timekeepers will be considered Judges of Fact.

ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRIES

Notification of acceptance of entry will be forwarded by e-mail to all Competitors in the week prior to the event. This advice will also include Further Regulations and other additional specific information on the running of Hillclimb events at Rob Roy.

INTEGRITY

Any Participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.

Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.
