CLASSES

The competition will provide for the following classes:

SPORTS AND SEDAN CAR CLASSES

- o RRI-J Sports & Sports Sedans Up to 1000cc
- o RRI-A Sports & Sports Sedans 1001 to 1300cc
- o RRI-B Sports & Sports Sedans 1301 to 1600cc
- o RRI-C Sports & Sports Sedans 1601 to 2000cc
- o RRI-D Sports & Sports Sedans 2001 to 3000cc
- o RRI-E Sports & Sports Sedans 3001cc and over
- o RRI-F Clubman sports all capacities

RACING CAR CLASSES

- o RRI-G Racing Cars Pre-1960
- o RRI-H Racing Cars Post-1960

Note: Turbo/supercharged type cars within the sports and sedan car classes will have the appropriate factor of 1.7 times the engine capacity applied to determine class placement. Rotary-engine cars will have a factor of 1.8 applied and a Turbo/Supercharged factor as appropriate.

RUNNING ORDER

Running order will be strictly as per the run group order as advise in the acceptance letter. Competitors will need to listen for PA announcements for their group call up and then make their way to marshalling.

AWARDS

Trophies will be awarded for first, second and third placings in each class. In addition, a trophy will be awarded for the Fastest Time of the Day and the Fastest Female Competitor. Trophies will be presented at conclusion of the competition.

RESULTS

TIMING

Timing will be electronic and be accurate to 1/100th of a second. Class winners will be those competitors with the Fastest Time for a single run in each class. In the event of a tie, the next fastest official time of each competitor will determine the class winner. Timekeepers will be considered Judges of Fact.
