- All vehicles must comply with Schedule A and Schedule B of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Approved helmets and apparel, in accordance with Schedule D of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.
- All competing cars must be fitted with a device that restricts the exhaust noise level to a maximum of 95dB(A) measured at a distance of 30 metres on a drive by test under full acceleration.
- Competitors must produce a valid and current: Motorsport Australia Competition Licence, Club Membership Card of a Motorsport Australia Affiliated Car Club, and Log Book (if issued).

## ENTRIES

Entries are open with the Publication of these Regulations, and close on the Sunday 18 May 2022. The Entry Fee is \$110, and for Juniors the fee is \$60. Entry is via the Motorsport Australia Event Entry system which is available at: - [www.motorsport.org.au](http://www.motorsport.org.au).

**CLASSES** The competition will provide for the following classes:

### SPORTS AND SEDAN CAR CLASSES

- RRI-J Sports & Sports Sedans Up to 1000cc
- RRI-A Sports & Sports Sedans 1001 to 1300cc
- RRI-B Sports & Sports Sedans 1301 to 1600cc
- RRI-C Sports & Sports Sedans 1601 to 2000cc
- RRI-D Sports & Sports Sedans 2001 to 3000cc
- RRI-E Sports & Sports Sedans 3001cc and over
- RRI-F Clubman sports - all capacities

Note: : Turbo/supercharged type cars within the sports and sedan car classes will have the appropriate factor of 1.7 times the engine capacity applied to determine class placement. Rotary-engined cars will have a factor of 1.8 applied and a Turbo/Supercharged factor as appropriate.

## RUNNING ORDER

Running order will be strictly in class order and within each class the order will be based on the car competing number as listed in the program. Competitors will need to listen for PA announcements for call up when to make their way to marshalling.

## AWARDS

Trophies will be awarded for first, second and third placings in each class. In addition, a trophy will be awarded for the Fastest Time of the Day and the Fastest female Competitor. Trophies will be presented at conclusion of the competition.

## TIMING

Timing will be electronic and be accurate to 1/100th of a second. Class winners will be those competitors with the Fastest time for a single run in each class. In the event of a tie, the next fastest official time of each competitor will determine the class winner. Timekeepers will be considered Judges of Fact.

## ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRIES

Notification of acceptance of entry will be forwarded by e-mail to all Competitors in the week prior to the event. This advice will also include Further Regulations and other additional specific information on the running of Hillclimb events at Rob Roy.

- Entries will be accepted in order of receipt unless otherwise specified.
- The organisers may refuse any entry in accordance with the NCR of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed / consented to by a parent/ guardian.
- Event organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event in accordance with the NCR of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Protests must be lodged in accordance with the NCR.
