ENTRIES

Entries are open with the Publication of these Regulations and Close on the Tuesday 12 January 2022. The Entry Fee is \$110 and for Juniors the fee is \$55. Entry is via the Motorsport Australia Event Entry system which is available at: - www.motorsport.org.au.

- B2** Sports Cars 2WD Open/Closed up to 2000 cc
- B3** Sports Cars 2WD Open/Closed 2001cc to 3000cc
- B4** Sports Cars 2WD Open/Closed - 3001cc and over
- B5** Prod Sports 2B & 2F - up to 2000cc
- B6** Prod Sports 2B & 2F - 2001cc to 3000cc
- B7** Prod Sports 2B & 2F - 3001cc and over

Third Category: Sedans

- C1** Sports Sedans – 2WD up to 1600cc
- C2** Sports Sedans – 2WD 1601cc to 2000cc
- C3** Sports Sedans – 2WD 2001cc and over
- C4** Sports Sedans – 4WD All
- C5** Time Attack – All
- C6** Improved Production – 2WD up to 1600cc

ROAD REGISTERED VEHICLES without a Motorsport Australia Log Book

The 2022 VHCC Standing Regulations state:-

Each automobile participating in the VHCC must be the subject of a Motorsport Australia Log Book. However, road registered vehicles with current registration or a current club permit may compete for VHCC points without a Log Book if they comply with an appropriate class to be adjudged at each VHCC round by the Clerk of Course with consultation by the Hillclimb Panel Eligibility Officer.

For those intending to move from non-logbook to championship points it is important to update your Car's profile in MA Event Entry by (1) nominating for a VHC class and (2) include the vehicle's registration number. Then bring a current vehicle registration document or a club permit to the event.

AWARDS

Trophies will be awarded for first, second and third placings in each class. In addition, a trophy will be awarded for the Fastest Time of the Day and the Fastest female Competitor. Trophies will be presented at conclusion of the competition.

RESULTS

These will be available on the MG Car Club's website - www.robroyhillclimb.com.au and the MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA Victorian Hillclimb Panel website – www.hillclimbvic.com.au – in the week following the event.

TIMING

Timing will be electronic and be accurate to 1/100th of a second. Class winners will be those competitors with the Fastest time for a single run in each class. In the event of a tie, the next fastest official time of each competitor will determine the class winner. Timekeepers will be considered Judges of Fact.

ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRIES

Notification of acceptance of entry will be forwarded by e-mail to all Competitors in the week prior to the event. This advice will also include Further Regulations and other additional specific information on the running of Hillclimb events at Rob Roy.

- Entries will be accepted in order of receipt unless otherwise specified
- The organisers may refuse any entry in accordance with the NCR's of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed / consented to by a parent/guardian.
- Event organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event in accordance with the NCR's of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Protests must be lodged in accordance with the NCR's.
